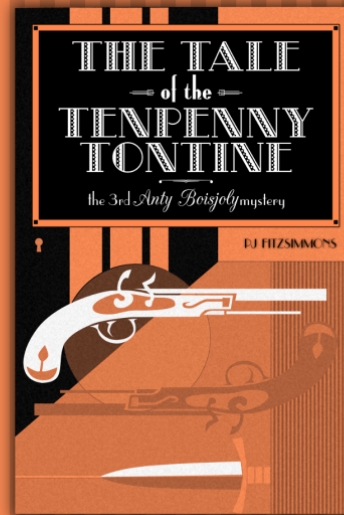


In Anty Boisjoly's
